The organization's activities report for 2021



General information:

The organization's license issued by the General Secretariat of the Council of Ministers in Baghdad No.1075356 on 9-5-2012, and the organization's license issued by the Department of Non-Governmental Organizations in the Kurdistan Region, registration number (134-i) and the date of issuance: 26-3-2013.

The organization aims to identify and raise public awareness of gender balance and human rights principles. The Gender Studies and Information Organization is a non-governmental and non-profit organization, with an independent legal personality, specialized in gender and women issues and working to consolidate democracy and the rule of law. And building civil society, through the implementation of programs and projects. The organization is a member of more than one network:

The main activities of the organization during 2021

During 2021, four projects were implemented, and the main activities for 2021 were as follows:

 From 25-3-2021 to 27-3-2021 our organization's activities included a training workshop on the rights of religious minorities as part of) the Iraqi Minority Rights Promotion) Programmed for (18) members of the Minority Alliance Network and the Iraqi Minority Alliance Network at the level of Iraq with funding from the NPA.











- Project (Promoting of women's participation in the upcoming elections in Iraq 2021). The project was carried out in three Iraqi governorates. (Erbil, Kirkuk and Diyala) With the participation of (50) organizations, (14) NGOs in Erbil Governorate, (12) NGOs in Kirkuk Governorate and (14) NGOs in Diyala Governorate, the project has a three-month duration from 23-6-2021 to 30-10-2021, volunteers of both sexes, the number of beneficiaries was (14,253) and the activities were as follows:
- Training course for project staff on 26-6-2020
- (452) Awareness sessions in Erbil governorate (154) awareness sessions (130) Awareness sessions for women the number of attendance (3655) and (24) Awareness sessions for men the number of attendance (1148). In Kirkuk governorate (148) awareness sessions (100) sessions for women the number of attendance (3555) and (48) sessions for men the number of attendance (816). In Diyala governorate (150) sessions awareness session (110) for



women Number of attendees (2943) and (40) sessions for men Number of attendance (586) Number of participants (14253) participants.

- Peer Education: (20) young men and women in Erbil governorate, (25) young men and women in Kirkuk governorate, and (20) young men and women in Diyala governorate were trained and sensitize young people and encouraging them to participate in the upcoming Iraqi elections.
- Peer Education. The total number of participants was as follows: (800) young men and women, (337) young women and (473) young men in Erbil governorate, (750) young men and women, (320) young women and (430) young men in Kirkuk governorate, and (700) young men and women, (253) young women and (417) young men, and (417) young men in Diyala governorate.
- Distributing (600,000) brochures on how to participate in elections, electoral awareness and encouragement to participate in elections in Erbil, Kirkuk and Diyala governorates, in awareness sessions and peer education.

On 26-6-2020, a consultative meeting was held in Erbil for project staff (strengthening women's participation in the upcoming 2021 Iraqi elections) to discuss the project and set up an action plan for the implementation of the project in three governorates (Erbil-Kirkuk-Diyala), the duration of the project is three months from 23-6-2021 to 30-10-2021 funded by UNDP-UNAMI.









4. On 27-6-2021, the Independent Electoral Commission was visited in Erbil and met with Mr. (Haider Ali), Director-General of the Electoral Commission, for the purpose of coordinating and cooperating in the implementation of our organization's project (Strengthening Women's Participation in the Upcoming Elections - 2021), funded by UNDP-UNAMI.







5. On 7-7-2021 the meeting of the administrative body of our organization at the organization's center in Ankawa for the purpose of consultation and implementation of the organization's projects and the participation of members in it.





6. On 4-7-2021, the team of our organization visited the Independent Electoral Commission in Kirkuk governorate and met with the Director-General of the Electoral Commission (Loay Arkan Ali) and the Deputy Director-General (Ahmed Laman) for the purpose of coordinating and cooperating in the implementation of our organization's project (Strengthening Women's Participation in the Upcoming Elections - 2021), funded by UNDP.







7. On 8-7-2021, a meeting was held with Mr. (Ahmed Mazen), Director of the Training and Media Department of the Independent Electoral Commission in Erbil Governorate, for the purpose of coordinating and cooperating in the implementation of a project (strengthening women's participation in the upcoming elections -2021).

On 12,13 & 14-7-2021, a three-day training course for (24) members of (12) non-governmental organizations in Kirkuk Governorate was organized within a project (Strengthening Women's Participation in the Upcoming Elections of Iraq 2021) to encourage women to participate in elections and vote for them in elections. NGOs were distributed to three constituencies in Kirkuk Governorate, funded by UNDP-UNAMI.











11. On 14 & 15-7-2021, a two -day training course for (24) members of (12) non-governmental organizations in Erbil Governorate were organized within a project (Strengthening Women's Participation in the Upcoming Elections of Iraq 2021) to encourage women to participate in elections and vote for them in elections. NGOs were distributed to four constituencies in Erbil Governorate, funded by UNDP-UNAMI.











12. On 15 & 16-7-2021, a two -day training course for (28) members of 14 non-governmental organizations in Dyala Governorate was organized within a project (Strengthening Women's Participation in the Upcoming Elections of Iraq 2021) to encourage women to participate in elections and vote for them in elections. NGOs were distributed to four constituencies in Diyala Governorate, funded by UNDP-UNAMI.











13. On 07/27-2021 a day-long training course was held for (25) young women and men (peer education) in Kirkuk governorate within the project (Strengthening Women's Participation in the upcoming Iraqi elections 2021) to encourage young people to participate in the elections at the three-constituency level in Kirkuk governorate, funded by UNDP-UNAMI.







14. On 7-8-2020 Day Training Course for (20) Young Men and Women Christians (Peer Education) from Shaklawa District within Project (Supportting the Electoral Process in Iraq) to encourage young people Christians in Shaklawa to participate in elections and vote for Christian Minority in Elections, funded by UNDP-UNAMI and Minority Alliance Network.









Project activities include:

15. Peer Education After training (20) young Christian men and women from Shaqlawa district, each participant interviewed (10) Christians from Shaqlawa for the purpose of encouraging them to participate in the upcoming Iraqi elections and to vote for minorities, especially for the Christian candidates they represents.





16. On 21-9-2021, our organization's activities raised awareness of (20) Christians in a project (Supporting the Electoral Process in Iraq) for the purpose of encouraging the Christian minority to vote for the Christian candidates in the elections, funded by UNDP-UNAMI and the Minority Alliance Network.

On 23-9-2021, one of our organization's activities raised awareness of (20) young men and women from (Akad Sports Club) within a project (Supporting the Electoral Process in Iraq) for the purpose of encouraging the Christian minority to vote for Christian candidates in the elections funded by UNDP-UNAMI and the Minority Alliance Network.

On 25-9-2021, one of our organization's activities raised awareness of (20) Christians from Armouta in Koyeh district in within the project (Supporting the Electoral Process in Iraq) for the purpose of encouraging the Christian minority to vote Christian candidates in the elections funded by UNDP-UNAMI and the Minority Alliance Network.


